English Revitalisers (englishrevitalisers.wordpress.com) support vocational practitioners to identify and develop English in their subject area; discover techniques to develop learners' confidence and abilities; help learners improve their English at the same time as developing their vocational skills.

- a short **pre-session** task
- a **full day, face to face training**
- a (confidential) **self-assessment** of own English abilities and confidence
- signposting to **online learning** to develop personal English
- a national forum to share ideas and approaches
